

## **Seminar on Building Information Performance 2025**

CIBSE Hong Kong Region co-organised the Building Information Performance 2025 with the HKIE Building Services Division (BSD) on 7 August 2025. This event brought together industry experts to explore the intersection of technology, data and sustainability in the built environment.

The seminar featured presentations from respected speakers from across the industry. Our Chair, Mr. Ethan Poon, presented on "Smart Thinking: Al-driven Energy Savings", highlighting how AI is transforming energy management in complex building systems. Our Immediate Past Hyvan Chair, Mr. Wong expanded conversation with his presentation on "Beyond Lighting Installation - IoT Structure", offering insights into the wider integration of IoT technologies in building infrastructure.
