

Programme Highlight:



Kai Tak Sports Park is a multi-purposes sports venue featured with a 50,000 seats main stadium with a retractable roof and bowl cooling system for seating area, an Indoor Sports Centre with the flexibility to host community sports and events of up to 10,000 seats and a Public Sports Ground with 5,000 Seats. It supports the Government policy to promote sports in the community, to support elite sport, and to maintain Hong Kong as a centre for major international sport event. The Kai Tak Sports Park is located on the north western part of the former Kai Tak Airport with an area of around 28 Hectares. It is within ten minutes' walk from both Kai Tak Station and Sung Wong Toi Station.

Apart from sport venues, there are park facilities and ample public space for events and leisure including 700,000 sq.ft. retail areas and a nearby 32,000 sq.ft. coastal dining areas making it the perfect spot to relax. Other facilities included Sports Avenue, Main Plaza, Event Village, South Plaza and Neighborhood Park.
