Dear Fellow Members,

I am very honored to have this opportunity to report the activities taken in the session 2022/23.

Technical seminars and site visits were jointly organised with ASHRAE HK Chapter and HKIE-BSD in various topics like IoT, BIM and Carbon Neutrality. One of the visited sites was the Shaw Auditorium in Hong Kong University of Science and Technology.

Besides, the Comprehensive Certificate Course on Fire Services Systems 2022 was jointly organised with HKIE-BSD, BSOMES and the Association of Registered Fire Service Installation Contractors of Hong Kong. There were totally 12 sessions covering the design, installation, operation & maintenance of Fire Services Systems. More than 300 participants were trained this year.

Industrial engagement with public sectors and various Institutions involved in different working groups. One of them was the Electrical and Mechanical Best Practice Group organised by EMSD. After two years, work Best Practice Guides in Electrical, Fire, HVAC, Lift, Gas, Solar Photovoltaic, Solar Water and LPG Vehicle were published.



The Joint Symposium jointly organised with ASHRAE HK Chapter and HKIE-BSD is the iconic event of Building Services Engineering every year. The theme of HKJS 2022 was City for Future-Journey to Carbon Neutral Building and CIBSE President Elect delivered the keynote speech. Speakers from leaders of different fields shared their experience and research results.

A social gathering with other professional institutions was held in December last year. The Joint Sport Competition with HKIE-BSD, ASHRAE HK Chapter, IFireE HK Branch and CIBSE HKR was organised. We also had the VR game competition, such activities really gave us a chance to relax and have team building practice.

President Elect and CEO of CIBSE visited HK from 18 November to 25 November 2022. They joined the annual Joint Symposium, visited various sites, professional bodies, and Govt. offices.

This year, we are glad that CIBSE granted two Bronze Medals to two members in Hong Kong, Mr. C M Chung and Mr. Peter Long.

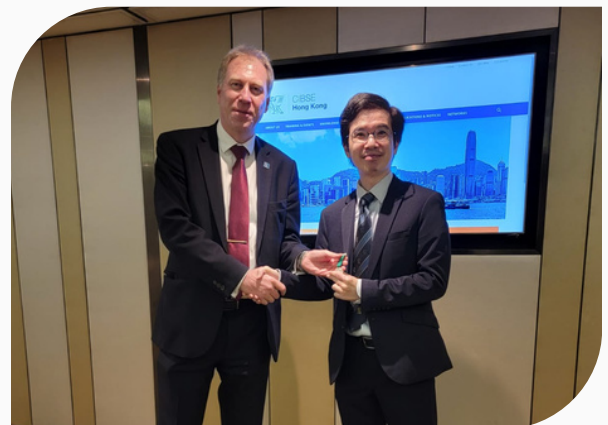

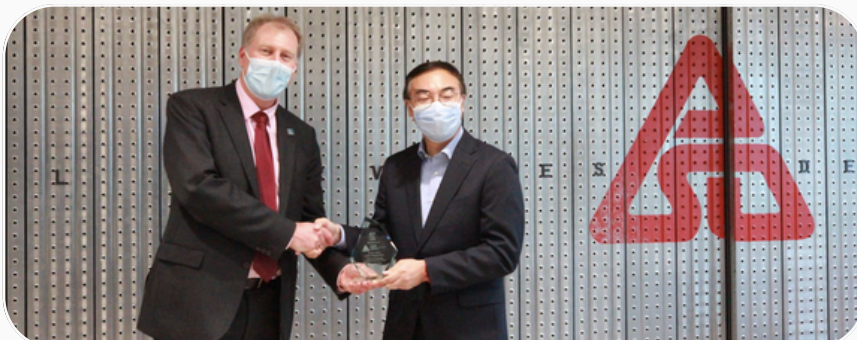
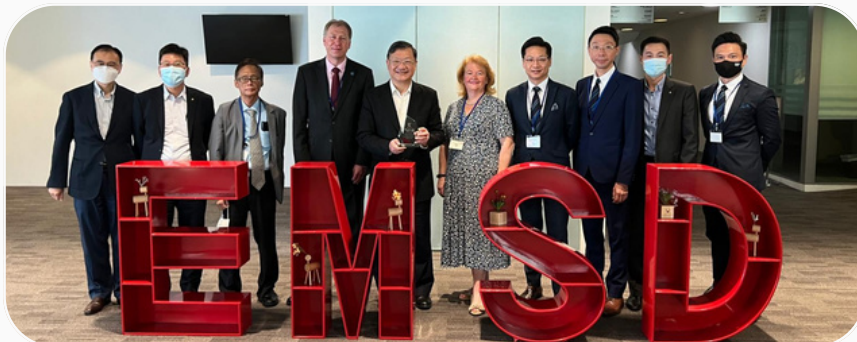
President Elect and CEO Visit 2022

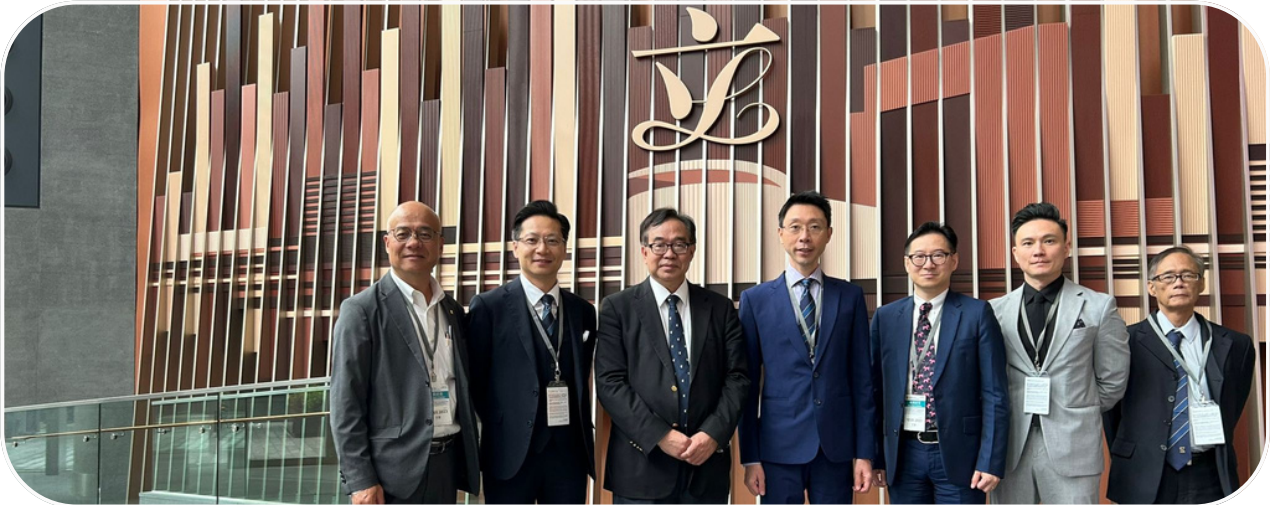

Joint Technical Visit to Kai Tak District Cooling System



A joint technical visit at Kai Tak District Cooling System (KTDCS), co-organised by the CIBSE Hong Kong Region, ASHRAE Hong Kong Chapter, and HKIE Building Services Division was successfully held on 29 April 2023. In total, approximately 30 participants joined this visit.

The implementation of district cooling systems (DCS) at the Kai Tak development and sustainability aspects of DCS were introduced during the visit. Participants were also given a guided tour of the district cooling plant, which consisted of the largest capacity of water-cooled chillers in Hong Kong. The plant's unique design for phased expansion to suit the development schedule of KTDCS was also introduced during the event. The visit provided an opportunity for participants to learn about the latest advancements in DCS technology and expand their professional knowledge. We would like to express our gratitude to the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department (EMSD) for providing us with the opportunity to visit the KTDCS North Plant, as well as the participation of all members from the aforementioned institutions. The visit allowed participants to witness the impressive scale of this giant, energy-efficient, and green infrastructure. The KTDCS demonstrated how economies of scale can be leveraged to improve energy efficiency, reduce carbon emissions, and provide resilience of building services system.

As engineers, it is essential to remain up-to-date with the latest advancements in technology and stay aware about the latest trends in the industry. Technical Visit to ATAL Wo Lee DfMA Center

The technical visit was successfully held on 23 July 2022 at ATAL Wo Lee DfMA Center with more than 20 nos. of participants by CIBSE HK Region YEN. It provided valuable insights into their use of advanced technologies and processes in the production of modular building systems. The center's use of BIM modeling, 3D printing, CNC machines, and robotic assembly systems was impressive and demonstrated the potential of DfMA to revolutionise the construction industry. The visit also highlighted the center's collaboration with the MiMEP (Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing Modularization) project, which aims to develop modular MEP systems for the construction industry.

In addition, the center's approach to DfMA included a focus on Building Service, ensuring seamless integration of MEP systems into the modular building systems. The visit emphasised the importance of precision and attention to detail in every step of the DfMA process, and the center's approach can serve as a model for other organisations looking to adopt DfMA practices.

(Highly Effective Deodorisation System)
- **Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP)**
(Purification of Wastewater for reuse)
- **Heat Recovery and Power Generation**
(Self-sustainable Energy and Electricity Exportation)

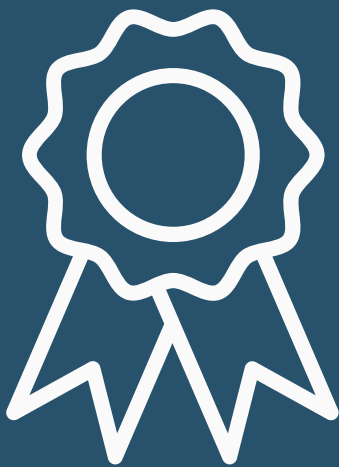
CIBSE HKR YEN Christmas Party 2022
